Log 30 miles throughout February 2025 on one, all, or any combination of trails in our diverse Brushy Creek MUD System!

SENDERO SPRINGS TRAIL



- █ This 0.8-mile gravel trail runs through the Behrens Ranch Subdivision.
- █ This 1.4-mile gravel stretch is the main trail that starts across the street from the Sendero Springs Pool parking lot. Trail markers every 0.1 miles.
- █ These are 0.1 - 0.2 mile trail extensions linking neighborhoods.
- █ This 0.9-mile gravel trail runs down the middle of the Great Oaks Dr. median.
- █ This 0.3-mile gravel trail starts at the Brushy Creek North Park and also hooks onto the main trail.
- ▲ Trail markers.

CREEKSIDE TRAIL TO CEDAR PARK

At roughly 7 miles from end to end, this trail is a combination of the Brushy Creek Trail System, Fern Bluff Trail System, and Williamson County Regional Trail System. It crosses over the Brushy Creek Lake Dam and ends at the Cedar Park YMCA.



- █ This 0.4-mile gravel trail spans from Great Oaks Drive to Creekside Trail.
- █ This is a 0.75-mile Fern Bluff MUD paved trail.
- █ This 0.85-mile paved trail runs along Hairy Man Road from its intersection with Great Oaks Drive.
- █ This 6.0-mile gravel road and paved trail spans from the corner of Great Oaks Drive along Brushy Creek Road to Cedar Park.

COMMUNITY PARK TRAIL



This 1.0-mile loop is a gravel trail that begins behind the fire station and connects to a paved trail that loops around the BCMUD Community Center and continues along the sidewalk to Great Oaks Drive.

This 0.25-mile gravel trail connects the main trail to Liberty Walk.

This 0.5-mile gravel trail connects the paved Community Center trail to O'Connor Drive.

This 0.5-mile gravel trail begins at O'Connor Drive and connects across the street from the northeast corner of Cat Hollow Park.

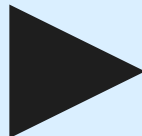
EPHRAIM TRAIL
